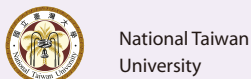
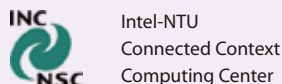

- Architecture and infrastructure design (including modeling and evaluation) for distributed and networked sensors and actuators
- Intelligent networks and communications
- Intelligent data processing, mining, fusion, storage, and management, context awareness, ambient intelligence
- Intelligent device and resource management
- Experimental prototypes, test-beds, and field trials experiences on smart services and applications, e.g., Smart cities, intelligent transportation, building automation, assisted living, e-health, etc.
- Business issues and value chain analysis (e.g., New value chains enabled by IoT and impacts on existing ones)
- Standards, user experience, and social issues
- Others

### SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Authors are invited to submit original papers that **MUST NOT** have been submitted to or published in any other conferences, workshops or journals. Full Papers (up to 8 pages) and Poster Papers (up to 4 pages) are solicited. All papers should be submitted in our on-line system <http://www.edas.info/N17361>. ### PAPER PUBLICATIONS

If the paper is accepted, at least one of the authors must attend the conference to present the work in order for the paper to be included in the IEEE Digital Library. Accepted papers will be published in the proceedings of iThings2014 by IEEE Computer Society (CPS). Extended versions of selected papers will be considered for publication in IEEE Internet-of-Things Journal.
